

Winners of the 2010 Rochester Regional Business Plan announced

Tenrehte Technologies Inc. was the top winner at the 2010 Rochester Regional Business Plan Contest, which encourages entrepreneurship and recognizes new, high-growth ventures in the Greater Rochester New York Region.

Their product, PICOwatt, a Wi-Fi enabled device that plugs into home appliances to monitor usage, also won the 2010 Best of CES Award for green technology in January.

The business was awarded \$25,000 plus incubation and marketing services.

Second place was awarded to FloodWatch, with their water detector device, and third was given to Wi3, a company that makes a device to connect home devices to one network. Winners were chosen from five finalists who were also awarded cash and service prizes.
